Coronavirus legislation places important legal obligations on those who organise funeral gatherings and those who manage the premises at which a funeral gathering takes place.

Funeral directors have a responsibility to make their clients aware of their legal obligations and to support them and the venue management (usually the crematorium or cemetery staff) in ensuring current rules are adhered to.
